ENROLMENT POLICY LOCAL AND OUT OF AREA

GUIDING PRINCIPLES	<p>Bonnyrigg High School believes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• every child has the right to attend BHS under the Parents' Right to Choose policy• students are entitled to be enrolled at BHS if they are in the schools' designated intake area• every parent of a BHS student has the duty to ensure their child attends school• no person will be discriminated against in enrolment• the primary criterion for acceptance of out of area enrolments will include the availability of school resources.
POLICY	<p>The Bonnyrigg High School community will enforce the NSW DoE enrolment policy by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• establishing an enrolment ceiling, based on available permanent accommodation• establishing a placement panel for out of area applications• ensuring that local intake area enrolments have priority to enrol, and maintaining a buffer for students who move into the intake area during the year.• considering out of area applications, which will only be accepted if they meet the requirements as set out by DoE Enrolment of Students in Government Schools, 1997.
OUTCOMES	<p>As a result, Bonnyrigg High School will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• maintain an enrolment panel comprising of the Principal and Deputy Principal/s.• fairly and equitably enrol students• assess enrolments based on specific criteria• ensure enrolments reflect community needs• maintain accurate and complete enrolment data.
