## Academic Selective Class Position Application Years 8, 9, 10 & 11 – 2026

Dear Parent / Caregiver,

Thank you for your interest in applying for an Academically Selective class placement in 2026 for your child.

The following process will apply:

- 1. A completed application form, available online at: https://education.nsw.gov.au/schooling/parents-and-carers/choosing-a-school-setting/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/years-8-to-12
- 2. Copies of the student's last two (2) academic reports.
- 3. A short portfolio of achievements and academic successes. The portfolio should also contain a written statement outlining why they wish to be in the Academically Selective class and what their future aspirations, post school are currently.

Please note an interview may be necessary.

Bonnyrigg High School will convene a panel to assess all applications. All applicants will be notified by mail regarding the success of their gaining an interview for a position.

Applicants will be placed in a priority order. Vacancies will be filled in this order and a reserve list created for all years. If a vacancy becomes available, the next student on the reserve list will be offered the position.

Applications must be submitted to Bonnyrigg High School by 3pm, 25 July 2025 the official closing time for all selective schools. Note: the application and portfolio must be complete, and copies of originals attached, as the school staff cannot photocopy any documents.

## Process for Application to enrol at Bonnyrigg Partially Selective High School – 2026

A selection Panel will gain an insight into prospective students' achievements, attitudes, commitment, and willingness to engage in school and community activities based on the following submitted with the application.

### 1. Round 1

Assessment of Application and Portfolio – please refer to the checklist for guidelines.

Each applicant will be assessed on their own merits and will take into account the portfolio, the personal data supplied, and the family's situation including proximity to educational services.

### 2. Round 2

Successful applicants will be invited for an interview in August / September, if required.

### 3. Round 3

Placements will be offered.

The Department of Education High Performing Students Team will notify Bonnyrigg Partially Selective High School when we can advise parents of the placement outcome.

Applications can be submitted via the front office from Wednesday 18 June 2025. The closing date for applications is Friday 25 July 2025. No applications will be accepted after this date.

There is no administration fee.
