Dear Parent/Caregiver,

In supporting NSW students in becoming work ready, the department has introduced HSC minimum standards testing. Students need reading, writing and numeracy for everyday life after school. This is why students in NSW are being supported to meet a minimum standard of literacy and numeracy to receive the HSC from 2020.

To show they meet the HSC minimum standard, students need to achieve Level 3 or 4 in short online reading, writing and numeracy tests of skills for everyday life. We will be running these tests for the entire year 10 cohort at the beginning of term 1.

Students who do not meet the required level 3 or 4 will be placed into a Literacy and/or Numeracy support class. Students will then be given the opportunity to re-sit their Minimum Standards tests at the end of each school term. Students are given a maximum of 4 opportunities per academic year to re-sit the test.
